Dog Assessment Enquiry Form (Non-UK Rescue)

In order for Pointers In Need to establish whether we can take a Pointer on for rehoming in the UK, we must ask that you provide us in the first instance with the following information about the Pointer for us to determine committing to take the dog on. Once we have all of the information, we will give you a decision within 48hrs of the full report, but we will endeavour to respond sooner if we can.


You will need to supply **all the information we have requested**, and in the fullest detail possible. It is important we have a full report and understanding of the dog. It is noted that it may not be possible to answer every question. This being the case, please explain why.

1	Please confirm your contact details; name, address, phone and email (please print clearly)	
2	Where are you based?	
3	Does the Pointer have a name?	
4	Is the Pointer a bitch or dog?	
5	How did you come by the Pointer, and when did he/she come into your care?	
6	Where is the Pointer currently being cared for?	
7	What is the Pointer's age – dob or approx. age?	
8	What was the Pointer's weight from day1 and the dog's current weight today(in Kgs)?	

9	What is the Pointer's height to the withers? (in cms)	
10	Has the Pointer been neutered?	
11	Are there any old/current injuries; disregard any normal day to day cuts and scars? Full details of the known injuries must be supplied.	
12	Does the Pointer have a microchip? If so, supply number and confirm where the chip is actually registered. Please also confirm what DoB is shown on microchip record.	
13	Has the Pointer seen a Vet and what veterinary advice/treatment is currently being carried out?	
14	What medication is the Pointer currently on?	
15	Have all blood tests been carried out, if so when were these and what were the results? If not, when will this be done?	
16	What is the Pointer's general temperament and demeanour with humans and other dogs?	
17	What is the Pointer's hunting instinct level?
